Developed by The Open University in association with the Police Service of Northern Ireland, the community safety series of free online courses provide an introduction to many modern aspects of policing with diverse communities, examining key topics such as leadership in policing, effective communication, collaborative problem-solving, community empowerment, approaches to working with children and young people, and the benefits of evidence-based policing.

The course provides relevant, up-to-date insights based on groundbreaking research by researchers from The Open University and around the world. The courses will also provide an invaluable background on policing perspectives to anyone working in policing or equally to those who might interact with policing bodies through their day-to-day work. This includes social workers, community associations, community safety professionals, and even just interested members of the public who wish to have a better understanding of modern policing.
